



IICRC Carpet Cleaning Technician (CCT) Course Outline

• This course is oriented to the residential carpet cleaner.

It covers all information in great detail needed to clean and restore residential carpets. Students are taken to a complete journey through a carpet's life cycle, from its inception as a filament, to carpet needing to be cleaned and restored. Time is dedicated to both problem solving and presenting time saving procedures. We stress the quality of work and service. There is time set aside for hands-on spot and stain removal, and cleaning, if class site and time restraints permit. Designer, new and difficult yarns are discussed, as well as yarn blends. This is a great course to help you clean area rugs!

Also included are exclusive photos in the textbook of a carpet mill tour. In addition, we have included residential carpet cleaning case studies. This allows the student to discuss what they have learned and what the applications of each type of home cleaning would take place.

Some additional time for marketing concepts is often included, time permitting. It is our desire to help the student get a fast return on his or her education. In addition, all students attending are encouraged to bring their questions and current cleaning issues to the classroom, so we may address them.
